



PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

Multifix-Standard is a cementitious-based wall and floor tile adhesive. It is formulated for its extended workability, ideal for both interior and exterior applications and unaffected by frost. **Multifix-Standard** adheres to most common building substrates i.e. concrete, sand/cement render and screeds, brick and blockwork.

APPLICATION DATA:

Ensure that the surface substrate being adhered to is clean, dry and firm. The surface should be free from of dust, dirt, oil and grease or any other contaminates. Please ensure that the surface is strong enough to support the weight of the tile and adhesive. To encourage best adhesion to your substrate it is advisable when applying adhesive to porous surfaces that the area be primed. Super-Add-P is an ideal surface primer, as it will help to prevent water penetration, increase bond strength.

Installation Methods:

Multifix-Standard should be added slowly to approximately 5 lit of water and should be mixed thoroughly to give a slum free easily worked adhesive. The mix proportions by volume are approximately 4 parts Multifix-Standard: 1 part water. Once the adhesive is fully mixed it is immediately ready for use and has a working time of approximately 1 hour at a temperature of 25 $^{\circ}$ C. We strongly advise that you do not mix more than can be used in this time and do not re-wet.







Apply the adhesive to a thickness of 3-6 mm up to 1 m at a time. On internal walls use a notched trowel, leaving ribs i.e. 3mmX 3mm at 6mm centres for mosaics, 5mmX 5mm at 10 mm centres for wall tiles, use the solid bed trowel method.

Large studded tiles should be buttered. Bed the tiles in with a slight twisting action. Leave spaces between the tiles for grouting (approximately 1-3mm for walls). Clean off excess adhesives from the tile face and grout lines with a damp cloth before it sets.

Grouting:

Leave for approximately 24 hours before grouting and/or walking on tiles (longer time may be required on impervious surfaces). Please consult our product guide for the recommended grout for application.

CLEANING:

All tools should be cleaned with water immediately after use.

STORAGE:

Store in dry, frost-free conditions at moderate temperature not *greater* than 25 °C.

SAFETY DATA:

- Irritating to eyes, respiratory systems and skin.

- Keep out of reach of children. In case of contact with eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of clean water and seek medical advice.
- After contact with skin, wash immediately with plenty of clean water.
